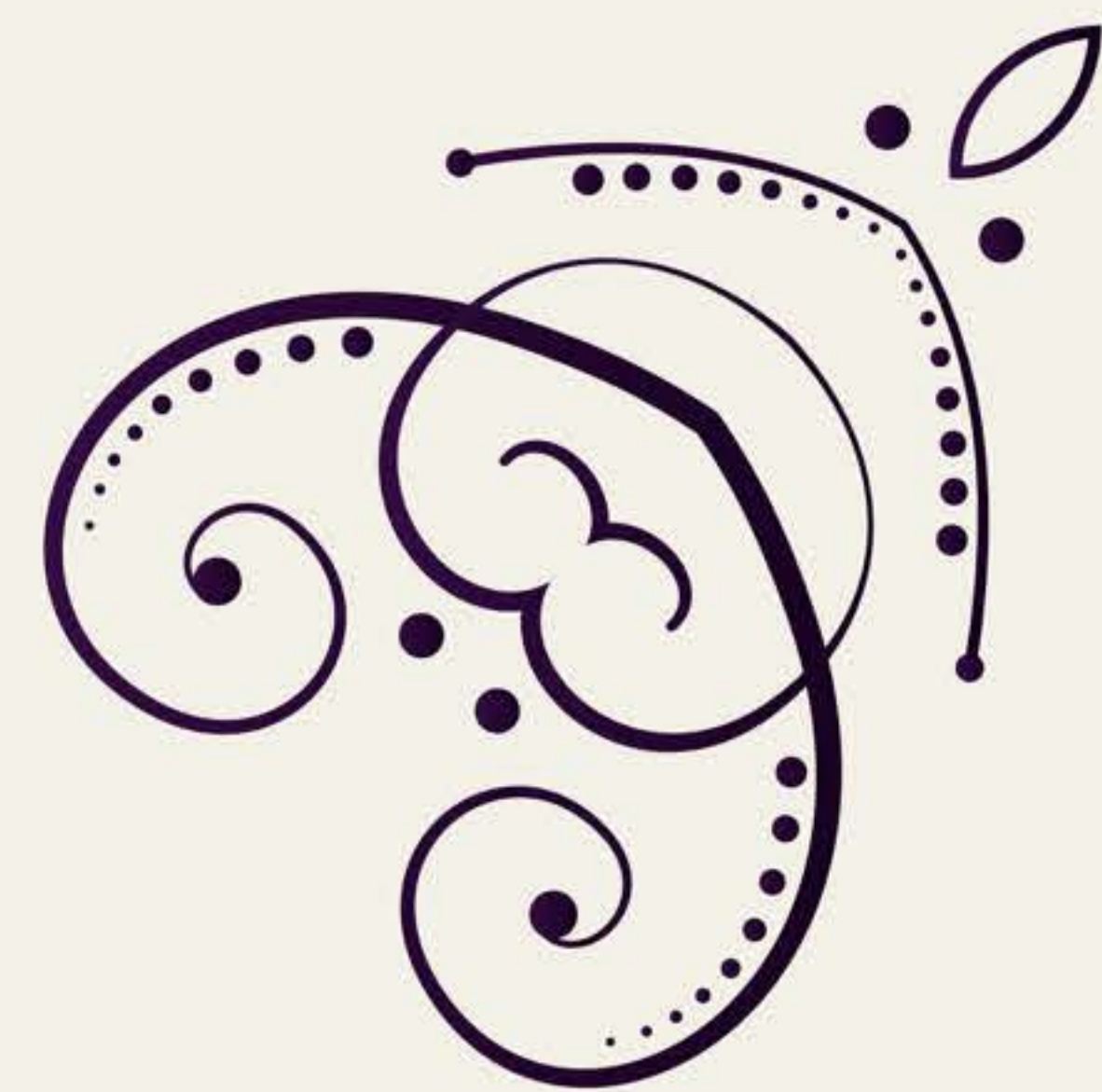
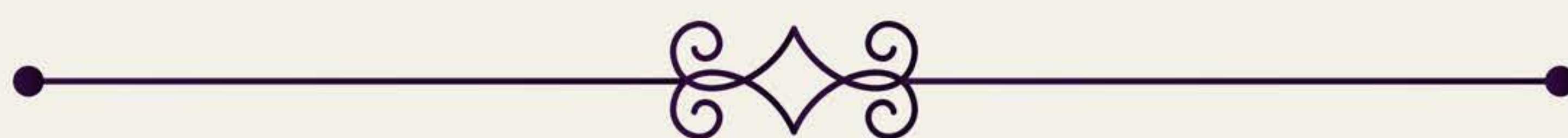
A celebration that has a unifying force to bring people together at KIIT. It was not merely a religious festival or a cultural extravaganza but a pious conglomeration of the young minds.)
