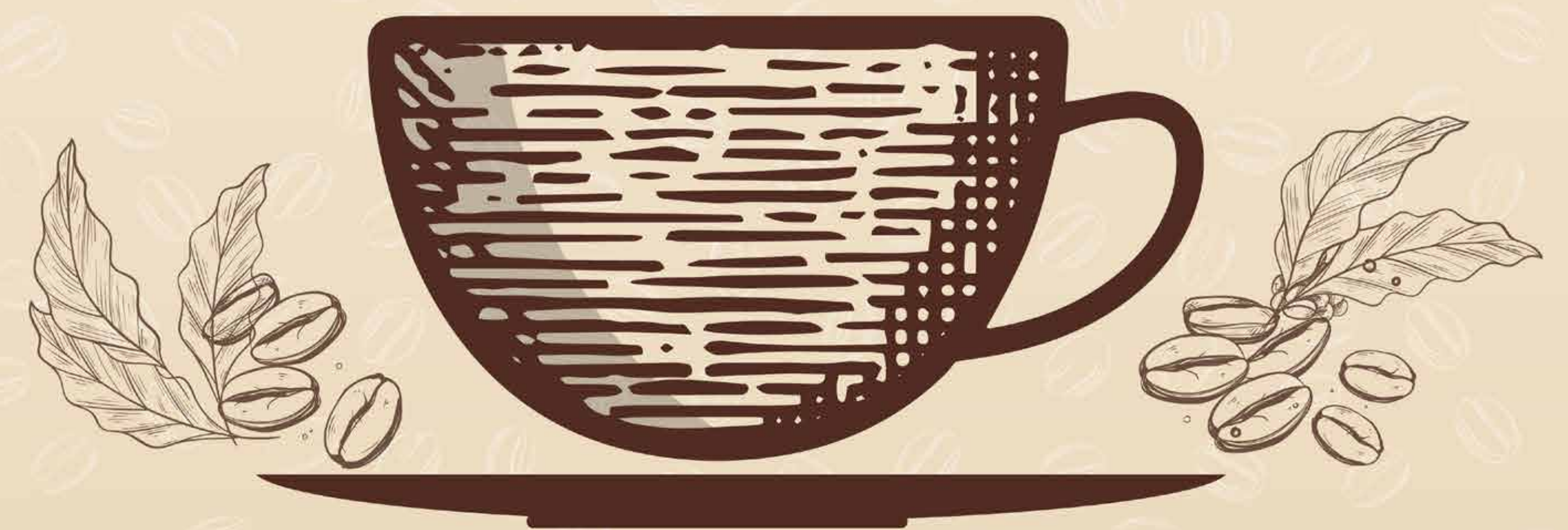


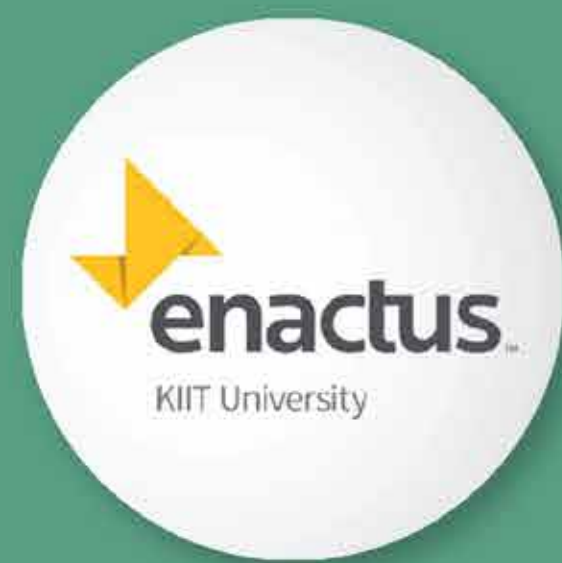

After the inaugural ceremony, Abhijeet Sahoo, Secretary-General declared the conference open and presented the report on KIIT International e-MUN 2021. The first day of the conference featured an invigorating speech by Sanya Seth, Programme Analyst, Intergovernmental Processes, UN Women and a motivating discourse by Tushar Kanti Das, Senior Program Manager (South & East Region), PLAN India. The day proceeded with sessions in the various committees of the e-Model United Nations, such as DISEC, UNHRC, WHA, SPECPOL, ECOSOC, UNPBC, UNFCCC, UN-WOMEN, UNSC and HCC. A total of about 600 international and national participants from a majority of European and Asian nations are participating in the 8th edition of KIIT International e-Model United Nations.

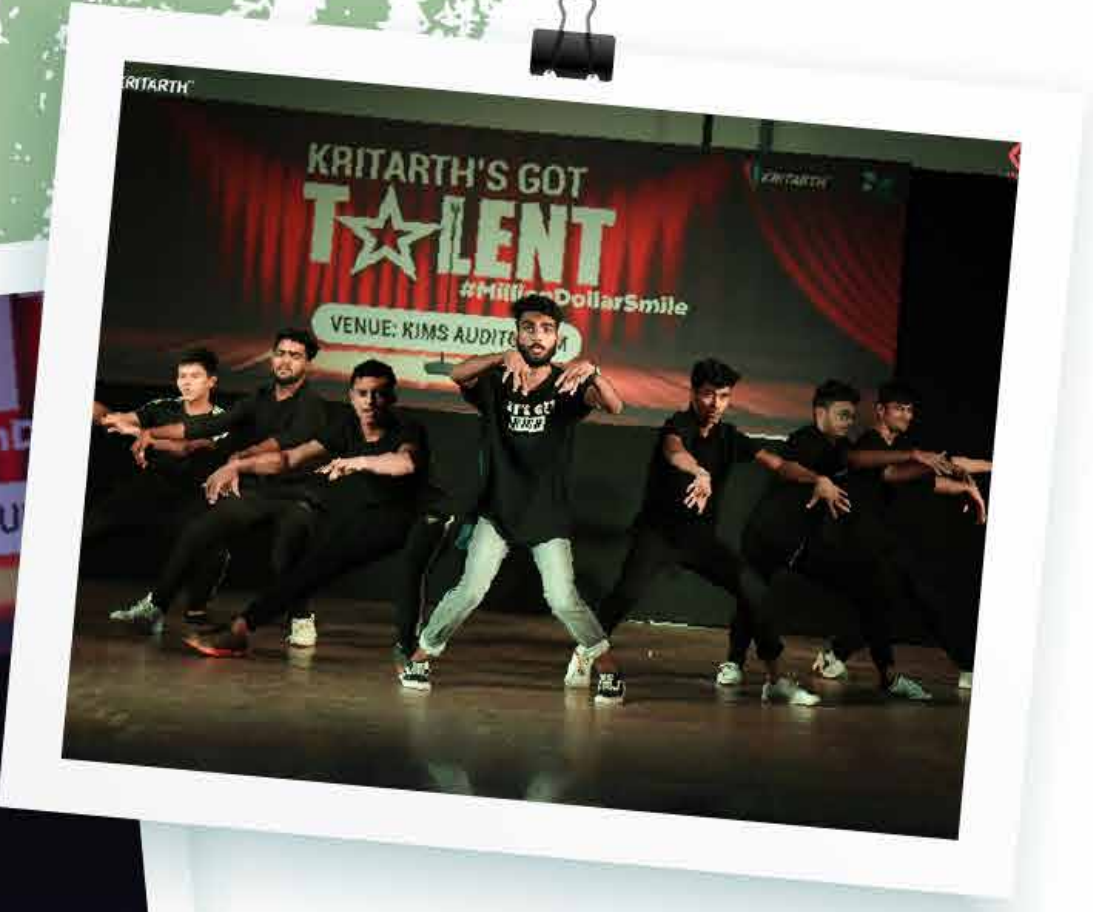

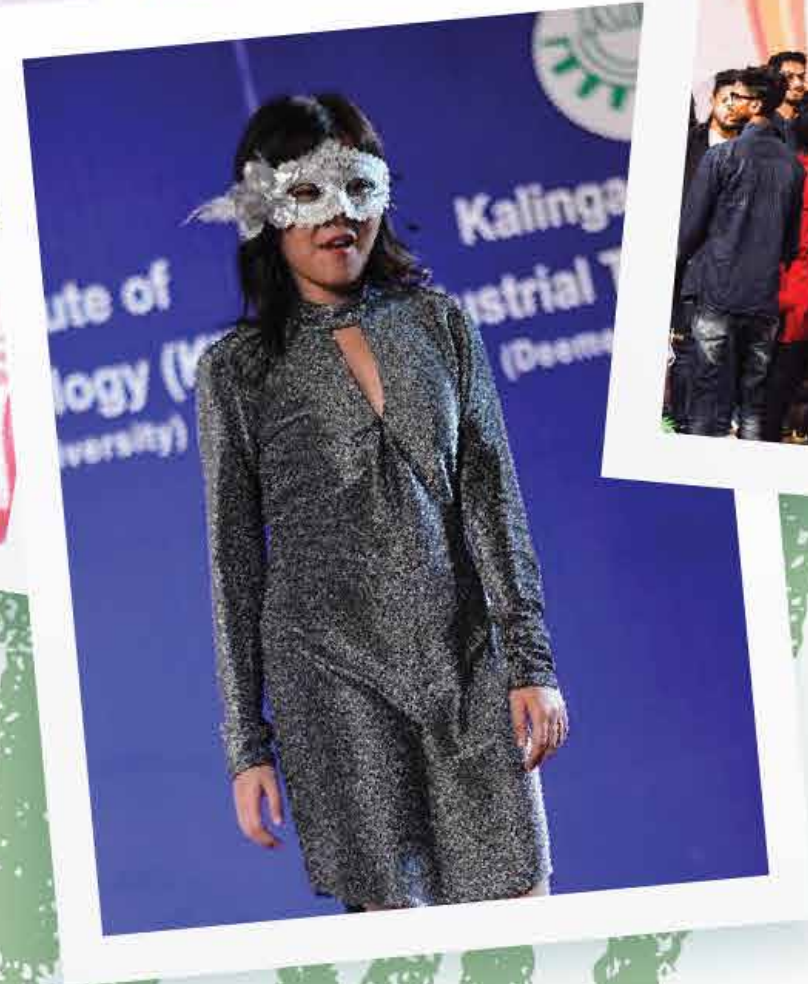


KRITARTH
